

Academic Half Day Cases - Respiriology

Clinical Presentations: Respiratory Distress

1. 3 year boy old presents with third wheezy episode lasting a week to 10 days after a viral infection.
2. 6 year old boy, with known asthma, presents with an acute shortness of breath after a birthday party at a petting farm.
3. 10 year old girl presents with hives, pruritis, facial swelling, wheezing, stridor, abdominal pain, vomiting and fainting.
4. 18 month old boy was playing on carpet with older brother and sister. Older brother was playing with legos and sister was playing with barbie. He coughs and vomits once witnessed by his siblings.
5. 6 month old boy presents with a barky cough that gets worse at night. He is worse when agitated or crying. Barky cough persists at rest. He has fever, coryza, and mild indrawing.
6. 20 month old boy presents with coughing, wheezing, shortness of breath, and difficulty feeding over 1-3 days. Crackles and wheeze are heard with a stethoscope.
7. 8 year old boy presents with cough, sore throat, low grade fever, nasal congestion, diarrhea, headache, loss of appetite and fatigue.
8. 8 month old girl presents with pallor, lethargic/limp, crying more than usual, poor feeding, restless/ irritable, high fever, and vomiting.
9. 16 year old presents with dry cough, low grade fever, headache and fatigue
10. Newborn presents with delayed passage of meconium in first 24 hours.
 - 4 month old presents with failure to thrive and frequent greasy stools.
 - 12 year old girl presents in asthma clinic with chronic cough, and clubbing. She has not yet started her periods.
